TEO POH LIAN BURSARY

The application is open to members who are pursuing higher education in local or overseas junior colleges, polytechnics or universities. The basic conditions for eligibility are as follows:

Basic Conditions for Bursary

1. Awards will be given based on the financial needs of the applicants. Applicants' total family income per capital must be less than S\$450/- (per month).
2. Applicants must have joined Handicaps Welfare Association (HWA) as an 'Ordinary' or 'Life' members, for a minimum period of at least one year, with subscription fee fully paid up.
3. Applications must have gained admission into the approved full-time institutions as follows:

Institution	Level
Junior Colleges / Pre-Universities	GCE 'A'
Technical Colleges (All Polytechnics and Institutes of Technical Education)	Diploma, Industrial Technical Certificate or National Technical Certificate.
Arts Colleges (Lasalle School of Arts and Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts)	As above
Commercial Educational Institutions (SIM, Informatics, Altron, BMC)	Diploma or Advanced Diploma
Universities (National University of Singapore, Nanyang Technological University.)	General Degree or Honours Degree

4. Only full time and local courses are recognised.
5. Applicants should not be holding another scholarship / bursary.

HWA SCHOLARSHIP

Basic Conditions for Scholarships

1. Applicants applying for Degree Courses must have good results as follows:
GCE 'A' level full certificate with 3 'A' & 'AO's (inclusive of General Paper)
2. For Diploma Course, the minimum requirement is as follow:
A full GCE 'O' level certificate with maximum aggregate for 5 subjects = 10
(including English)
For applicants who passed their 'O' level in 1990, maximum aggregate for 6 s subjects =12
(including English)
3. For applicants applying for the subsequent year of study, the applicants must obtain an overall grading of 'B' and above. It shall be the discretion of the Committee to determine the overall results of the applicants
4. In marking awards, merits in academic performance, moral character, records of involvement in community services, extra-curricular activities, potentiality for employment of the applicants shall be taken into consideration.
5. Applicants should not be holding another scholarships or bursary.
6. Applicants must have gained admission into the approved full time degree / diploma course, in one of the approved institutions mentioned below:
 - National University of Singapore
 - National Technological University
 - Nanyang Polytechnic
 - Ngee Ann Polytechnic
 - Singapore Polytechnic
 - Temasek Polytechnic
 - La Salle School
 - Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts
 - Singapore Institute of Management
 - Singapore Management University
7. Applicants who gained admission to overseas full time degree / diploma course may also apply but the courses must be recognised by PSC and approved by HWA.
8. Applicants must have joined Handicaps Welfare Association (HWA) as 'Ordinary' or 'Life' members, for a minimum period of at least one year, with subscription fully paid up.

Acceptance of application for both the bursary and scholarship do not imply or guarantee award of bursary or scholarship. Full details of the bursary and scholarship, terms and conditions and application forms can be obtained from HWA reception counter. The Committee reserves the right to reject any application without assigning any explanation whatsoever and decision made shall be final and binding. Applications must declare all information and/or submit documents as stated in the terms and conditions and/or the application form. Members should only apply either a bursary or scholarship and those who are waiting for results can also submit the application first.
